Program Notes:

<u>Asante</u> is Swahili for "thank you." Mr. Dittgen composed the piece using several traditional African instruments and syncopated melodic rhythms.

A *Berceuse* is a musical composition resembling a lullaby, typically in triple meter. Jay Dawson masterfully uses the mallet instruments to convey a gentle mood.

Big Adventure was written for the Middle Tennessee State University front ensemble (Marching Band 'Pit'). It was used as a high-energy, pop-feel "parking lot" tune.

<u>A Night In Tunisia</u> is a jazz standard, arranged for percussion with a slightly different feel by Ms. Downs. According to Dizzy Gillespie's friend Art Blakey, he was with Dizzy around 1941-42, in Texas, when the song was written ... on the bottom of a garbage can.

<u>Hushabye Mountain</u> is the haunting lullaby from the 1968 film *Chitty Chitty Bang Bang*. In the movie, Dick Van Dyke's character builds complicated inventions, including a music box. Mr. Primatic emulates that sound by using the colors of the bells, crotales, triangle, finger cymbals and wind chimes.

<u>A Child's Dance</u> is an upbeat, lively piece written for 11 players (so Mr. Andrews gets to play along!). The inscription reads: for Alyssa, Brianna and Ezekiel.
