San Diego Optional Activities

Balboa Park

Spend a day exploring any of the 15 museums, many restaurants and shops, and the San Diego zoo at Balboa Park. Be sure to take a break on one of the park's many shaded lawns. The streets are home to musicians, entertainers, and artists during the day. Music drama fills the air after sundown!

La Jolla Bay

Known for its spectacular shoreline and sophisticated shopping, La Jolla Caves descend 133 narrow sandstone steps to sea level. See fossilized shells and mineral deposits. La Jolla cove is super for scuba diving & snorkeling. La Jolla Village Square is comprised of a 12-theatre complex, department stores and The Children's Museum of San Diego.

Old Town

The birthplace of San Diego, Old Town is now a living Museum and Cultural Park that recreates life in the Mexican and early American periods of 1821 to 1872 constructing a feel of a Southwest marketplace. Spend an afternoon exploring its many historic buildings & shops, some of which are in or near five original adobes. Tours daily at 2:00 pm for Casa de Machado y Silvas.

Point Loma

Cabrillo National Monument commemorates the Spanish discoverer of San Diego. For an insight into the past, wander through the 1854 restored lighthouse here! The National Park Service building offers a wealth of information, so make sure to stop by. Spectacular views of the city skyline and ocean can be seen from Point Loma and in January and February you can spot migrating whales in these waters.

San Diego Harbor Excursion

Harbor tours with nightly dinner and dance cruises. Take a one- or two-hour harbor tour of the North and/or South Bay. Depending on the tour you choose you may see Harbor and Shelter Islands, Point Loma, Cabrillo National Monument, North Island Naval Air Station, the Submarine Base, or the Coronado Bridge and much more!

San Diego Wild Animal Park

A 2,200-acre exotic animal and botanical reserve dedicated to the preservation and protection of endangered species. Newest feature is the 30-acre *Heart of Africa* safari walk. Also features a guided monorail tour, Mombassa Lagoon, hidden jungle butterfly exhibits, and a bird show.

San Diego Zoo

World famous and the largest zoo in the United States! Home to 4,000 rare and endangered birds, mammals, reptiles and 6,500 varieties of exotic plants. Make sure you visit the giant pandas and koalas during your visit.

Seaport Village

Provides shopping, dining, and entertainment on the Bay. The Village offers 75 one-of-a-kind shops, award-winning restaurants, and eateries. Also located in the village is the Broadway Flying Horses Carousel, which has been bringing excitement and nostalgia since 1980. Open daily 10am to 9pm.
