## Nick Rueckert

A native of the twin cities in Minnesota, pianist Nick Rueckert has lived in Iowa and performed in the Midwest since he completed his undergraduate degree at Drake University in 2011. Since then, Nick has been a regular member of the Des Moines Big Band and has performed frequently with The Turner Center Jazz Orchestra, Parranderos Latin Combo, The Des Moines Metro Concert Band and Big Band, and alongside a variety of local and visiting artists. He arranges and composes music for his own project, the Nick Rueckert Quartet, as well as for the Max Wellman Sextet. Nick completed his master's degree in music from Boston University in 2019, taught instrumental music in Iowa public schools for 11 years and currently maintains his own private jazz piano studio. In 2022, he received the Des Moines Community Jazz Center's "Special Recognition" award.
